

# **Employment**

66 Korean nationals were employed with Hamburgbased companies and liable to social insurance. This figure equals a share of 6.9 per cent of the total number of Korean nationals aged between 18 and 60 years living in Hamburg.

# Education

During the school year 2015/2016, 60 Korean students attended general education schools in Hamburg.

During the winter term 2014/2015, 180 students from the Republic of Korea enrolled in Hamburg's colleges, 73 of whom at the Hamburg University, 51 at the University of Music and Theatre, 26 at the University of Fine Arts and 17 at the University of Applied Sciences.


18,568 Korean automobiles were driven by Hamburg residents, among them 12,614 Hyundai, 5,912 KIA and 42 Ssang Young models.
